

# Winter Emergency Parking Ordinance

## 7-6-7: LIMITED WINTER PARKING:

A. Parking Restrictions: At such times as there is an accumulation of two inches (2") of snow on the streets in the city or the city has declared a snow emergency, it shall be unlawful for any driver or owner of any vehicle to obstruct the orderly removal of snow from the city's streets, alleys or public ways by parking, permitting to be parked or otherwise leaving unattended any vehicle upon the following streets, alleys and public ways:

1. On the even side of the street (as indicated by address) on even days (as indicated by date) between the hours of seven o'clock (7:00) A.M. and seven o'clock (7:00) P.M.
2. On the odd side of the street (as indicated by address) on odd days (as indicated by date) between the hours of seven o'clock (7:00) A.M. and seven o'clock (7:00) P.M.

The parking restrictions of this subsection shall terminate block by block as soon as the accumulated snow has been removed from the full width of the street, and at such time regular parking regulations shall go back into effect immediately. Nothing contained in this subsection shall be construed to permit parking on streets where parking is otherwise restricted or prohibited.

B. City Parking Lots: Any other provisions of this code notwithstanding, parking or standing of any vehicles shall be prohibited in city parking lots between the hours of two o'clock (2:00) A.M. and six o'clock (6:00) A.M. on any day after a snowfall of two inches (2") or more has accumulated.

C. Vehicle: For purposes of this article, the term "vehicle" shall refer to, but is not limited to, an automobile, a motorcycle, a truck, a semitrailer, a tractor, a trailer, a bus, a camper, a motor home, a motorized bicycle, a boat on a trailer, a snowmobile, an all-terrain vehicle, a farm implement and generally all other classes of vehicles, whether or not self-propelled.

D. Violation: The police department is hereby authorized to issue a citation and/or cause the towing, removal and storage of any vehicle which is in violation of this section, consistent with the provisions of section [7-11-8](#) of this chapter. (Ord. 882, 2-18-2014)
